

From the full moon to the last quarter in the months of April, May, and June, Gladden Split and Silk Cayes Marine Reserve come alive with the aggregation of several different species of Cubera and Mutton-Snappers, Jacks, and other Pelagic species in huge schools. The spawning of snappers attracts the world's largest fish; the Whale Shark (gentle giant) which feeds on the spawn and other plankton in this nutrient-rich part of the reef. Don't miss the opportunity to scuba dive or snorkel with this magnificent creature. Its a once in a lifetime opportunity and an exciting experience.



Monkey River Jour

Being one of Belize's first river tours, this top-rated tour is a great way to experience an abundance of wildlife sightings. From start to finish you can expect to spot all different types of flora and fauna. A local guide leads the tour slowly upriver pointing out exhilarating creatures such as crocodiles, iguanas, monkeys, river turtles, and many different species of birds. There's a small hike into the jungle where there's a 90% chance of a close encounter with the Howler Monkeys. After the hike, you return downriver to have lunch at the village. The tour then heads back to Placencia, but not before stopping to look for Manatees in their natural habitats.


