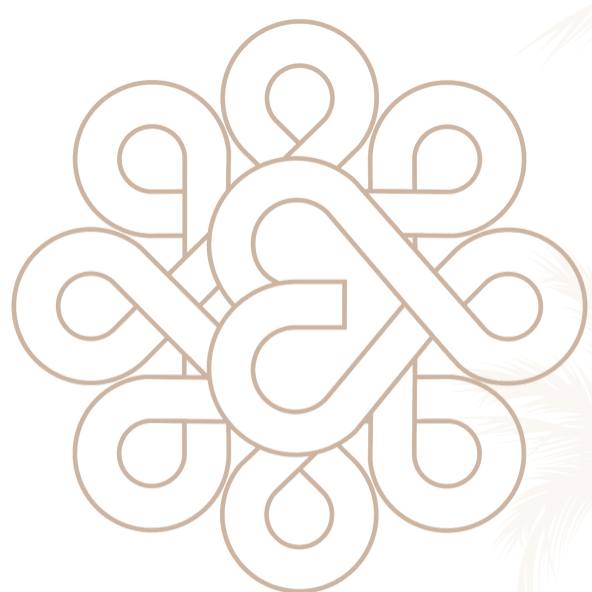

Xunantunich Mayan Temple and Cave Tubing or Inland Blue Hole Swim

Scarlet Macaws at Red Bank

Whale Shark Diving
